TO apply for a Louisiana statewide concealed handgun permit, most people are required to take a certified training course taught by NRA & state-certified instructors.

OUR instructors are certified by both the NRA and the Louisiana State Police, and are experienced former police firearms instructors.

WE offer special training such as the National Rifle Association PERSONAL PROTECTION COURSE, which is specified as proper training in the statute as required by the legislature.

THE course is generally conducted on specified Saturdays from 0830 until 1500 (3:00 PM).

THE first part consists of nomenclature of revolvers, semi-automatics, and single-action revolvers—how they work, how to handle them safely, ammunition choices, sight picture, alignment, dominant eye, and range safety.

AT the conclusion of this introductory portion, we go to the range for the live-fire portion of the class. Everyone will shoot at least one box (50 rounds) of ammunition. Since this is a lot of fun for everyone, many folks will find themselves shooting even more than this.

THE rest of the morning and early afternoon finds you back in the classroom where you will study Use of Deadly Force, Louisiana Law and Handguns, Child Access Prevention, and Avoiding Violent Confrontations. In other words, the course has taught you how to use a handgun, when to use it, and how to avoid getting into a dangerous situation to begin with.

UPON successful completion of the course, you are awarded a completion certificate which proves to the LSP you have received the basic training required to apply for a permit.

OUR course is a well-designed and enjoyable introduction to handguns and personal self-defense—suitable for almost any age except the very young. In fact, many family groups take the course with us.

WE also advise and assist you in applying for your permit, and proper completion of the paperwork in the application packet. Passport photos (required) are generally available at a very reasonable price. If you have any further questions about the course, or the application process, please feel free to e-mail or call.

## **CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT COURSE...Page 2**

**IF YOU ARE RENEWING YOUR PERMIT, you attend the class beginning at 10:00 AM.**

**Persons taking the course for the first time must attend the safety and familiarization portion of the course beginning at 0830.**

Classes are held monthly at the BAKER RANGE, a family-owned shooting center located at 3220 Jefferson Street in Baker, La. Their phone number is **(225) 775-2268**.

To get to THE RANGE from Baton Rouge, take I-110 North past the Airport Exit (Southern University Exit), to the HWY 19/SCOTLANDVILLE/BAKER exit (approximately 1.5 miles.)

Head North (right) on HWY 19 approximately 3.8 miles. This becomes MAIN STREET of Baker. Look for the intersection with GROOM RD. with MAIN STREET in the middle of Baker.

Go to the third street past GROOM RD. This is JEFFERSON STREET. There is an old Sonic Drive-In on the corner. Turn right. The BAKER RANGE is located ½ block off HWY 19 on the right. It is directly across the street from BUFFALO ELECTRIC. You may park in Buffalo Electric Co.'s parking lot after regular business hours.

***TO PICK UP, TURN IN CCW APPLICATION PACKETS, GET FINGERPRINTED, ETC***

The headquarters for the Department of Public Safety is located in the new State Police complex off Independence Blvd. Turn on **Public Safety Blvd.** and drive to it's end in the parking lot in front of the DPS. An information center is at the front door, and packets are generally available there. The office is open 0800—1600 (4:00 PM) Monday-Friday.
